# Olympic Day To Be Celebrated June 18<sup>th</sup> at WakeMed Soccer Park with 2008 Olympian MeChelle Lewis

National Olympic Committees (NOCs) throughout the world will also participate in the international celebration, with each Olympic Committee sending Olympic Day greetings to participating nations.

After running a personal best of 10.97 at the Olympic Trials, MeChellle Lewis made her Olympic debut in 2008, at the Beijing Olympics. Lewis was a three-time All-American at the University of South Carolina, and one of the American Advertising Federation's Top 25 Most Promising Minorities in Advertising.
