Important Information about the Triangle Youth Clinic

Hello,

Thank you for signing up your child to participate in the 2018 Triangle Youth Clinic presented by Dick's Sporting Goods!



The clinic is sure to be a memorable experience! To make sure things run smoothly, we have laid out details surrounding the event below.

Some things to note about next Saturday:

- Players will be grouped by age and/or skill level. Each group will rotate through various stations designed to aid improvement in all key areas of the game.
- Instructors will be comprised of current and former collegiate coaches, and current and former high school coaches and players. A list of the lead coaches can be found at www.trianglesportscommission.com/triangle-youth-clinic/
- *Clinic participants are expected to bring their own equipment.* Some bats and helmets will be provided for drills, but participants are encouraged to bring their own should they have them. If a participant does not have a glove, the parent should alert the Triangle Sports Commission as soon as possible.
- The lunch provided during the Clinic will be Chick-fil-A. If you have noted in your registration that your child has allergies, a separate email will be sent to confirm their lunch. Should a child not be able to have Chick-fil-A, other lunch arrangements will be made for them.
- A limited number of parking spots are available at Durham Athletic Park. Street parking is available as well. The TSC will follow up with an email next week about where to park, should the lot at the DAP fill up.
- When you and your child(ren) arrive, you will check in at table at the entry to the ballpark along the first base line. Parents are welcome to stay throughout the camp. Should you have two children, both in different age groups, the parent must pick up the younger child at 1.
- Please remember to have your child wear sunscreen, hat, sunglasses, etc.

ACC Baseball Semifinal Discounted Ticket Information:

- Discounted tickets for family and friends of Clinic participants are available for the 5 pm ACC Baseball Semifinal Game on May 26.
- Tickets will be in Section 213 in rows N through X for \$12. The Clinic coaches and participants will sit in the first few rows and family and friends will sit behind them.
- *Discounted tickets are on a first come first serve basis.* Ticketholders will be placed into the first available row and seats for the number of tickets bought.
- Tickets can be purchased online through Eventbrite, by check, or by cash onsite at the Clinic.
- Should you pay by check, the check should be made out to the Triangle Sports Commission. Checks can be mailed (though they must be at the TSC office no later than Thursday, May 24), be dropped off at the TSC office, or presented at the Clinic.

- All tickets, whether they are purchased in advance or at the Clinic, will be issued once you check in your child that morning.
- After the Clinic, the participants may join in the Parade of Athletes and walk around the field before the start of the Semifinal game. Details will come in another email next week.
